Course Plan

Course Description

CLASS PREPARATION

Discussion / Participation

The student's attendance and participation is imperative to the learning process. Exposure to the material at home through assigned material and the attentiveness in the classroom will be conducive to a higher comprehension of the material. Each student is expected to attend class, unless there is an overwhelming circumstance, notify the facilitator if a class will be missed. The priority is that you may be prayed for and that the student remains abroad with coursework.

Assignments

Each week there is assigned reading; utilize each day to advance, do not stay behind. Exposure to material by reading, through evaluations after each chapter, by responding to each chapter questionnaire, and finally summarized by the facilitator is what will give you success.

FINAL EXAM

A final exam will be administered in Class 8. The exam will be closed book. For the students that present online, they will log-in to their student portal and proceed; the grade will be given instantly after submitting exam. A two (2) hour window will be given to each student to complete the exam and the option to take a hardcopy exam with use of a scantron. Students will take exam on the same day and time irrelevant to the format chosen.

Plagiarism, whether purposeful or unintentional, includes copying or paraphrasing materials from a study guide, textbook, or any other published or unpublished source. Words, thoughts, or ideas taken from any source must be properly documented according to the Global University Undergraduate Form and Style Guide.

3. Fabricating: falsifying or inventing any information, data, or citation

4. Obtaining an unfair advantage:

- a) stealing, reproducing, circulating, or otherwise gaining access to examination materials prior to the time authorized by the instructor or examination supervisor;
- b) unauthorized collaboration on an academic assignment;
- c) retaining, possessing, using, or circulating previously given examination materials where those materials clearly indicate they are to be returned to the examination supervisor or to the Global University offices at the conclusion of the examination.

Disciplinary action for not maintaining standards of academic integrity range from lowering a grade for a paper to dismissal from the program, depending on the severity of the offense.
